# **MVCA**

## **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

Miami Valley Christian Academy, a Christian educational institution, through its Trustees, officers, faculty, staff, students and supporters, is bound in sacred covenant to preserve, defend and practice the "faith once delivered unto the saints" as contained in Holy Scripture and as stated in the following propositional truths:

- 1. We believe the Bible to be the only inspired, infallible Word of God and that it is the final authority in faith and life.**
- 2. We believe there is only one living and true God, eternally existing in three persons - the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, who are the same in substance, power and glory.**
- 3. We believe that Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, true God and true man, and that He lived a perfect and sinless life.**
- 4. We believe that man was created in the image and likeness of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical, but also spiritual death, which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature, which is enmity against God, becoming sinners in thought, word and deed.**
- 5. We believe the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, as a substitutionary sacrifice, was resurrected, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return to set up His Kingdom on Earth to reign in righteousness and justice.**
- 6. We believe that Salvation is by grace through faith and that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God, and that the Holy Spirit indwells all believers.**
- 7. We believe there are two ordinances, Baptism and the Lord's supper, which are divinely enjoined upon all Christians. Without merit in themselves, they provide an expression of faith regarding the believer's identification and fellowship with Christ.**
- 8. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the conscious punishment of the lost.**
